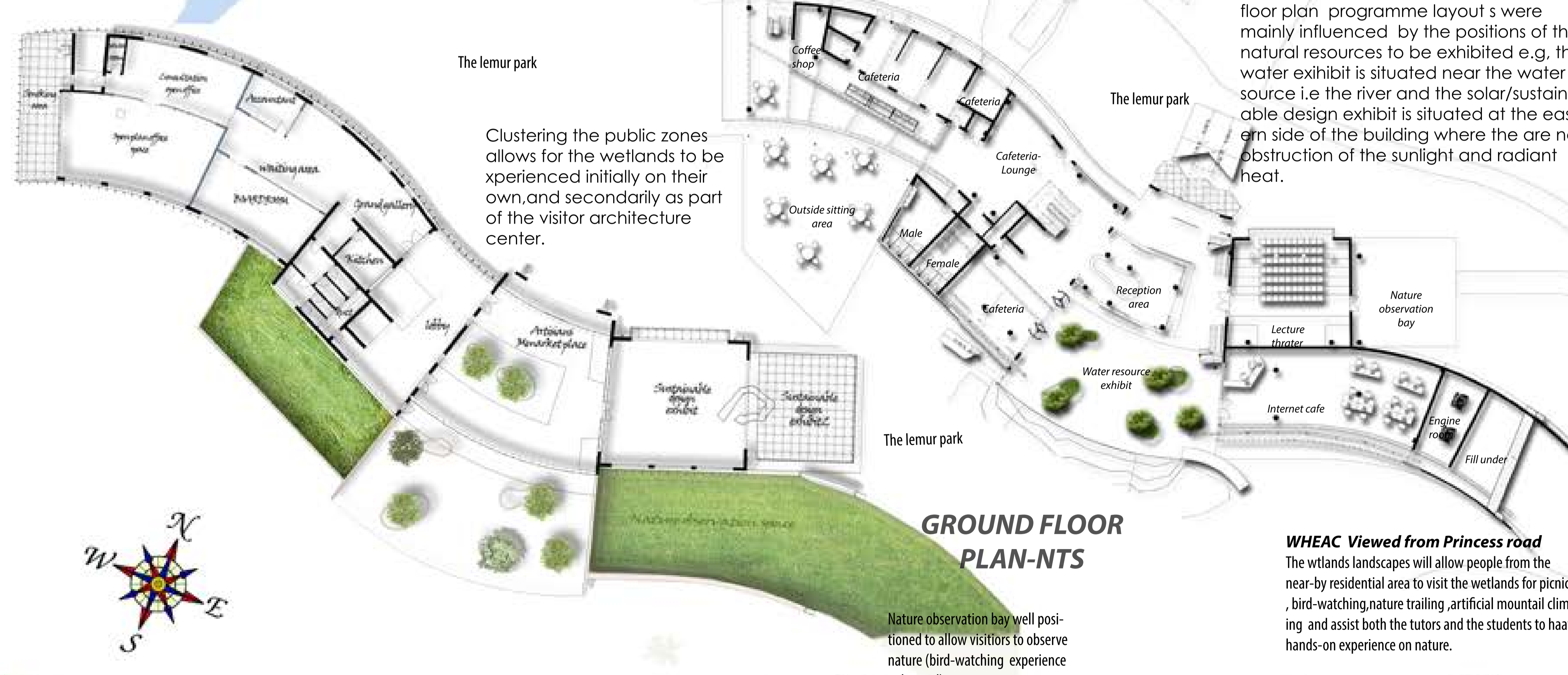
The northern entrance
